Our services

Learn & Play Equipment

Newlife's Play Therapy Pods give disabled children from across the UK the chance to learn and smile. Our free loans of specialist toys improve learning and help children gain crucial key skills that support them through life. They help children interact with parents, carers, siblings

and friends and support smiles – which in the face of painful or debilitating conditions can be rare.

In 2022 we provided 1,306 toy pods to disabled children.



Newlife's equipment loans help the most at risk disabled and terminally ill children and their families – children who, for whatever reason, simply cannot wait for vital equipment. Our unique service covers the whole


of the UK, delivering equipment nationwide within 72 hours after an application is received.

In 2022 we helped 387 children in crisis.

We're here for children and their families when they need us most, and the stories we receive from them mean so much.


These shared stories are of hope and resilience, they demonstrate how together we can help to change the lives of thousands of families every year.

Oscar and Theo's story:

Both Oscar and his brother Theo have the same incredibly rare neurological condition which means they have a shortened life expectancy.

To make the most of their short lives, parents, Cortney and Stuart desperately wanted to find a way to help Oscar and Theo improve their mobility, learn new skills and, most importantly, create lasting memories and special bonds, as a family – so turned to Newlife's Play Therapy Pods loan service for help.

Now, thanks to the contents of the Discovering Interaction pod, Oscar can develop his motor skills and reach developmental milestones – while Theo uses the Sensory Play pod to stimulate all his senses.



Leia's story:

Leia, aged three, was provided with a specialist seat from Newlife after a kidney transplant, which meant she could recuperate comfortably and happily at home.

Born with a rare genetic disorder Leia has developmental delays, epilepsy, and severe muscle weakness, so she can't sit without support, walk or talk.



She also had kidney disease, but the donation of a kidney from her dad, Tom, means this is happily no longer the case.

Thanks to the specialist seat Leia now has somewhere of her own to sit – and the smile on her face shows how much she loves it!

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Although her recovery was the initial reason we needed the P Pod, it's now a key piece in our home. It's easy to move anywhere we need it, even the garden, so she can always be with us.

Michael's story:

A new specialist buggy has made a huge difference to the life of eight-year-old Michael and his family, enabling him to go out and about and enjoy new experiences.

At two years old Michael was diagnosed with a rare genetic condition called Phelan-McDermid



syndrome, which means he has global developmental delay and severe learning disabilities.

His NHS wheelchair was only suitable for use on flat surfaces, restricting his family on where they could take Michael and go for walks or days out. But an all-terrain buggy from Newlife means he can be taken to variety of different off-road areas such as nature trails, which are quieter and less stimulating to settle him, and the family find it easier to get out together.

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
With the buggy from Newlife we go on different walks. When he gets upset, I will pop him into the buggy and he calms down within two minutes of being in it as he feels so secure and settled, it's like a magic pill. It has opened-up possibilities and opens-up the world for us. It means we can enjoy our time together.
