From beds, buggies, wheelchairs, and sensory toys, we help to ensure that disabled and terminally ill children can receive the specialist equipment that they need to fulfil their potential. However, we can't do it alone.

Parents and carers of disabled children have been disproportionately affected by the cost-of-living crisis with two thirds of the families that receive equipment from us on low incomes and living in poverty. In the first half of this year, we have seen a rise of 163% in applications for essential equipment when compared to the same period last year. As a charity we need your help to make sure that disabled and terminally ill children receive the life-changing equipment they deserve.

You can help by joining us for Sparkle Day on 1 March 2024. Our annual awareness day brings people together across the country to wear something sparkly and raise funds, providing a fun opportunity for the pupils and staff at your school to help brighten the lives of children living with disabilities and terminal illnesses.


