By supporting Sparkle Day, together we can make sure disabled and terminally ill children receive the life-changing equipment they deserve.




A bit about Newlife

Now more than ever



Parents and carers of disabled children have been disproportionately affected by the cost of living crisis, with two-thirds of the families that receive equipment from us on low incomes and living in poverty.

In the first half of 2023, we saw a rise of 163% in applications for essential equipment when compared to the same period last year.

Play Therapy Pods

Our free loans of specialist sensory toys empower disabled children with learning opportunities, essential skills, and joyful moments, as well as the opportunity to bond and enjoy play time as a family. Toys are available to suit a range of abilities and ages, starting from birth.



Equipment Grant Service

Newlife knows the difference having the right equipment at the right time can make to a disabled or terminally ill child. Our Equipment Grant Service provides the correct specialist equipment to offer comfort, prevent injury and enable more independence, enabling your child to thrive in their daily life.



Emergency Equipment Loans

Essential equipment is delivered urgently to vulnerable disabled and terminally ill children across the UK within a week of receiving the application, to provide vital equipment when it's most needed.



Free Nurse Helpline

Newlife's dedicated helpline is staffed by specialist nurses who are there to help families in need, whether they are struggling with a recent diagnosis and need information and support, or are facing day-to-day challenges of their child's needs.

Raising Awareness





How your help makes a difference

A portable hoist from Newlife has made life much easier for 15-year-old Rhys Porter from London who has Cerebral Palsy affecting both arms and legs and means he can now experience so much more in life.

Not only does the hoist mean Rhys can be moved safely without risk, either to himself or his parents, it also allows him more freedom and independence so he can easily go to watch his favourite football team and even play wheelchair football himself, as well as enjoy days out with family and friends without so many restrictions.

Mum Kelly said: "We didn't have a hoist at home that Rhys could use so his dad and I would have to carry him, which we shouldn't really be doing. He needed both hips and femurs broken and reset, so we urgently needed a hoist for him as it was the only way we could move him post-surgery. Thankfully Newlife was able to quickly help. We literally don't know what we would have done without it. It's given him so much more independence."
