Thanks to the help of our fantastic supporters, throughout 2023 we were able to provide essential specialist equipment and support to thousands of children and their families around the UK, ensuring that, regardless of their disability, children get to flourish, thrive and unlock their full potential.









Patrick's Story

In December, we launched an appeal to fund a 'life-changing' specialist seat for eight-year-old Patrick. Patrick has a rare brain condition that means he can't walk, talk, sit up or even hold up his own head; he has limited life expectancy and has frequent intensive care admissions for severe chest infections. He desperately needed a specialist seat called a P Pod to keep him angled in the correct position so he can breathe properly – and thanks to the generosity of people donating to our appeal, Patrick received his seat in the first week of January.



Mum Victoria said: "We had an old P Pod for Patrick but it was much too big and didn't give him any support, so his chin would touch his chest and his breathing would become really bad. When the new P Pod from Newlife arrived, we put him in it straight away and you could instantly see his SATS rise on the monitor, so we knew his breathing had improved straight away. The new chair holds his body in the correct position, so his airways are more open, which is fantastic."

Now Patrick is safe and comfortable in his P Pod it means he can also spend more time bonding with his siblings, including his twin brother Frederick.

Victoria added: "Patrick seems much happier in himself and is smiling. I know he's safe and comfortable now, so I don't have to worry so much.

"It's thanks to the help of everyone that we've been able to get the chair for him. We will be forever grateful to them."

Can you join the fight to give disabled children the future they deserve?

Every day, Newlife strives to do everything we can to make a real, lasting difference to the lives of disabled and terminally ill children around the UK.

It is estimated that it costs three times the amount of money to raise a child with disabilities than a non-disabled child, forcing many families to turn to charities such as Newlife for help. In the past year Equipment Grant applications to Newlife from families have nearly doubled compared to the same period last year, while total contacts to our Nurse Helpline from families and professionals seeking support has seen an increase of 73%.

Currently, there are more than 1.6 million disabled children in the UK – an increase of 60% over the last decade. As such, it has never been more important for local services to be robust and responsive to evolving pressures. This includes the need for a holistic and proactive approach to equipment provision. However, the reality is far different.

Our latest campaign report, **Fight For Our Future: ACT now for Disabled Children,** reveals a shocking picture of the challenges facing families just to

get access to the essential equipment such as wheelchairs, buggies, car seats and specialist beds - their children need to stay safe. With statutory funding for equipment stagnating and unable to cater to the rising demand, as well as waiting times for assessments at an all-time high due to a shortage of healthcare professionals in the workforce, families are being left for too long without the vital provisions they need.

Fifteen-year-old Rhys is one of the faces of our campaign. Fight for our Future. Rhys is an avid football fan and loves nothing more than watching his beloved Fulham FC with mum Kelly and dad Adam. Rhys also has quadriplegic cerebral palsy, which affects all four of his limbs and all aspects of his day-to-day life.

Sadly, Rhys and his family found themselves continually let down by the system that was supposed to help them. For three years the teenager was left without a hoist, meaning that the only way he was able to use the toilet was with a bucket and commode seat in his bedroom.

Mum Kelly explains: "We needed a hoist to move Rhys safely, but our house just isn't big enough to accommodate a larger fixed hoist, so we knew we needed a portable hoist. As Rhys needed major orthopaedic surgery to break and reset both his hips and femurs, a hoist would be even more necessary afterwards as we wouldn't be able to do any manual handling of him."

Following a three year battle with their local statutory services, which were unable to provide the portable hoist the family needed because it was simply not their policy to do so, Rhys faced having his surgery cancelled as there was no way to safely move him during his recovery period at home. In desperation Kelly contacted Newlife, who provided a £2,100 portable hoist in a matter of days, allowing the surgery to go ahead.

"Thankfully Newlife was able to quickly help. We literally don't know what we would have done without it." said Kelly. "It's given him so much more independence."
